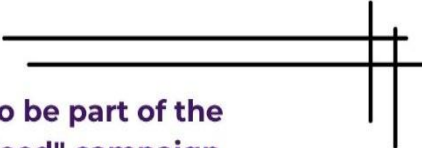

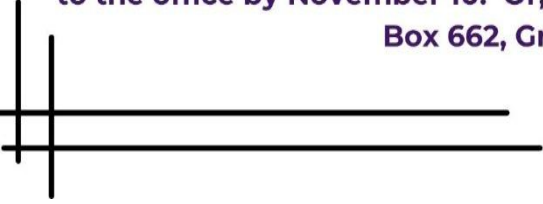

Fellowship Time is getting an update...

Beginning in October, you will see a change to the Fellowship Hosting Sign-Up sheet.
The 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month will be “Freezer Cookie” days.
